Beginning balance for October was \$22,890.35 with contributions of \$150.00 and expenses of \$1,056.72 leaving a balance as of October 31, 2011 of \$ 21,983.63. A motion was made and seconded to approve the report. Motion passed.

Guest Speaker: Peter Feaman, candidate for National Committeeman from Florida. He briefly explained the function of the National Committeeman and why it is important to send Conservatives from Florida to the National Committee:

- Marco Rubio and Allen West need support.
- Important to send true Conservatives from Florida to keep the National Committee "honest"

Elections

- Florida Presidential Primary is January 31, 2012. We are prevented from spending any funds on campaigns except Federal funds 120 days prior to the election.
- 3rd Party Registration – Chairman Simpson will e-mail out the letter he received from the Division of Elections with the registration ID number for the Jefferson County Republican Party (3P11-118). Registration agents must complete a Form DS-DE 120 and signed forms must be returned to the Division within 10 days of signing. These forms will also be available from the Chairman and should be returned to him.

- A motion was made and seconded to endorse Peter Feaman for National Committeeman. Motion was approved without objection.
